Summer Reading Project Assignment

After reading one book with a health related topic, complete one of the following assignments. This assignment will be graded upon completion and is due during the third week of the school year. **The book is not allowed to be one that you already read in 6/7th grade or will read in 8th. It will not count as a grade if you do this!**

1. Write about something that happened in the book in the same way a newspaper reporter would describe it. A reporter tries to answer these questions: Who, What, Where, When, Why and How. Make up an interesting headline for your newspaper article and make it look like an article. It should **be about 5-6 paragraphs**.
2. Add another chapter to the book. Tell what happened next or add an adventure/situation that was left out. It should be **at least 2 pages** (if typed, then please double space, using 12 for word size, in Times New Roman font).
3. Write an ending to the book that is different from the one the author wrote. It should be **at least 2 pages** (if typed, then please double space, using 12 for word size, in Times New Roman font).
4. Make a comic strip about one of the scenes in your book. **It must include color and descriptions in at least 6 boxes**. Creativity and effort are counted heavily for this.
5. Design a new picture jacket for the book, **including a new description** of what the book is about.
6. Write a pretend letter to a character in the book. Tell the character any similarities and/or differences you have with him/her. It must **be at least 1 ½ pages** (if typed, then please double space, using 12 for word size, in Time New Roman font).
7. Make a collage/scrapbook of things related to the book. **Be sure to label** what you put in the book. It must **be at least 5 scrap/collage pages**.
